Interdisciplinary areas in the ISAT department are Applied Biotechnology, Energy, Engineering/Manufacturing, Environment, Information and Knowledge Management and Telecommunications, Geographic Science, and Intelligence Analysis.

Candidates must have broad interest in and qualification to participate across the ISAT curriculum and must have expertise and demonstrated experience in computer networking and telecommunications. Additional interest in network security, network programming and/or network design is highly desirable. Candidates should have strong interest in teaching at the undergraduate level and should be able to team with other faculty within and outside the ISAT department to design, develop and teach courses. He or she would serve both as a colleague and advocate for ISAT and ISAT/Telecom internally and externally. The ideal candidate will understand, embrace, and advocate the ISAT Department's culture, which employs multidisciplinary approaches to problem solving.

Successful candidate should have a Ph.D. (or near defending his/her Ph.D. dissertation) is preferred but a Master's degree is required and industrial, business or governmental hands-on experience is highly attractive.
